

## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Virtual 38<sup>th</sup> EuroQol Plenary 2021

22 - 24 September



Provided below you will find important information regarding the Call for Abstracts for the Virtual 38<sup>th</sup> EuroQol Plenary 2021:

### The organisation of the scientific programme

- The Scientific Chairs are appointed by the EuroQol Executive Committee to develop the scientific programme and to chair the Plenary meeting.
- Each abstract submitted through the Portal will be reviewed and independently rated by members of the EuroQol Group. These reviews provide the basis for decisions about which to accept as papers and posters and which to reject.
- The Scientific Chairs will check the papers and posters when they are submitted. They reserve the right to exclude papers and posters that are not of an acceptable standard, exceed our word/page length limit, or are on a topic that differs from the initial abstract.
- Their aim is that each EuroQol Working Group will be represented in the papers as well as the poster sessions.

### Key topics of strategic interest to the EuroQol Group

The EuroQol Group's Executive Committee has established several Working Groups, each charged with specific objectives relating to the scientific agenda of the EuroQol Group. A summary of each Working Group's activities and research priorities is available [here](#). Those intending to submit abstracts are encouraged to consult these summaries as they indicate the topics and issues of greatest interest to the EuroQol Group and inform you about planned or ongoing activities that may be relevant to the work you intend to present.

Papers that report only on clinical or economic applications of the EQ-5D in specific sub-populations or disease areas, e.g. economic evaluations, are usually not accepted unless they contain methodological innovations that have wider relevance to the Group. These could include, for example, broader perspectives in using EQ-5D products in clinical settings and for decision-making in health care, and the conceptual basis for generic-based health-related quality of life measures.

Note that while our plenary meeting is primarily intended for members of the EuroQol Group, we welcome abstracts from *any* researcher whose work has potential interest or significance for the development of the EQ-5D.
