

The EQ-5D-Y-5L

is a new generic measure of HRQoL for use in children and adolescents

A valuable addition to the EQ-5D family of instruments

Developed through a robust **research process** with input from children and adolescents

Free of charge for **non-commercial** purposes; **commercial** users are charged a **fee**

Formats

Available as **digital** and **paper** formats for self-completion (ages 8–15 years). Also as **interviewer-administered** and **proxy** versions (ages 4–15 years)

A **valid, reliable,** and **responsive** instrument with **evidence of psychometric performance** from studies on 5 continents

Several languages available with more in development

Structure

5 dimensions and **5 response levels** to measure the child's HRQoL today. It has a similar **question-and-response** structure to the EQ-5D-5L, allowing for **greater comparability** and **easier transition** to the adult instrument

User Guide

includes details on the instrument's characteristics and development, and how to report and analyse EQ-5D-Y-5L data

Ongoing work to develop **country-specific value sets** that will allow for the estimation of QALYs
